



MAKE A SIMPLE BIRD FEEDER

Join us in making your very own bird feeder for your garden or local outside area. Hopefully you will then be able to see lots of different birds.

TASK INSTRUCTIONS

EQUIPMENT

- Empty toilet roll tubes
- String
- Peanut Butter
- Bird Seed
- Plate or bowl
- Scissors

1. Gather your equipment
2. Tie a loop of string all the way through the middle of the tube,
3. Stand the toilet roll tube in a vertical position. Spread a thick layer of peanut butter onto the tube. Ensure you cover the entire outside of the roll.
4. Pour the bird seeds onto a paper plate and spread it out evenly.
5. Spread bird seed on a paper plate
6. Gently roll the toilet paper roll tube around in the seeds, pressing down gently to encourage as many seeds to stick to the peanut butter as possible.
7. This bird feeder will hang horizontally. Bring the two ends together at the top and tie the string into a knot.
